PUTRAJAYA: Members and frontliners of the National Cooperative Movement of Malaysia Bhd (Angkasa) will soon receive contributions in the form of personal protection equipment (PPE) and daily basic necessities from the cooperative.

Angkasa president Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah said they have allocated a contribution of RM700,000 in the form of PPE and basic necessities.

"A total of RM15,000 in aid will also be allocated to respective state Angkasa offices for them to purchase PPE and daily necessities for members, as well as those working on the frontline.

"For the basic necessities, they will be distributed through each cooperative under the 'Barang Asas 100' (BA100) programme.

"Under this programme, we encourage the public to conduct cashless or online shopping transactions, as we want to minimise the spread of Covid-19 infection," he said when met at the contribution handover ceremony at the Home Affairs Ministry here.

The donation was handed over to Home Minister Datuk Seri Hamzah Zainuddin. Also present at the ceremony were Angkasa deputy president Datuk Kamarudin Ismail and Shence Pack managing director Shen Set Ho.

Fattah also said a total of 10,000 Angkasa B40 members nationwide are expected to receive contributions from the cooperative.

He added that Angkasa will continue to provide contributions in a bid to help those in need and to combat the Covid-19 pandemic in the country.

"(This programme) is in line with our principles which are to uphold democracy, to help one another, to boost the economy and (to ensure the welfare of) the community."
